Gifts support the care of injured and non-releasable hawks and owls at the Raptor Center, program scholarships for youth, college internships and landscape stewardship.

Contributions may be made to the Center for the Performing Arts, Palmer Museum of Art, Penn State Centre Stage, Music at Penn's Woods, and many other programs in the arts including the Blue Band, which qualifies donors to be members of the Floating Lions Club.

Gifts to this fund will provide financial support for faculty and staff facing a wide range of personal or family hardships. The fund enhances the quality of life and improves the mental, emotional and physical well-being of employees and members of their household during difficult circumstances.
